Fine motor skills development—Planting a seed

Gross motor skills development—bean bag toss, scrubbing vegetables

Comprehension—retelling the story, asking questions about the book, "picking" carrots and preparing our own food

Developing self-control—taking turns, sitting still and listening to the story, transitioning from one activity to the next

Learning new words-defining unfamiliar words, naming vegetables, talking about the story
